- Watch suitable TV programmes in MTL
- Listen to radio programmes

#### **READING**

- Revise the Chinese characters/
   Malay & Tamil words taught
- Get your child to read aloud the P3 texts with you
- Use 5W+1H to strike a conversation with the child about the text read
- Read MT story books (Important)

Write card/ journal/ short notes
