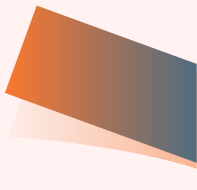
Edusave Merit Bursary

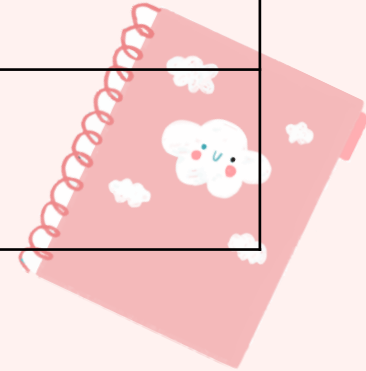
Good Progress Awards
