B. THE STRAITS TIME SCHOOL POCKET MONEY FUND (STSPMF)

The application for The Straits Times School Pocket Money Fund (STSPMF) for 2020 is now open for P1- P5 students. Those who are interested can retrieve the application form from the General Office. The closing date for students to submit the application will be **Fri**, **23.08.2019**. Students from low-income families, including MOE FAS students, who are successful in their applications, will receive the monthly school pocket money of \$60.

Students have to meet the following criteria to be eligible for the STSPMF:

- a. Student is a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Singapore Permanent Resident (SPR); and
- b. Family is living in a 4-room HDB flat or smaller; and
- c. Family has a Gross per capita income (PCI) of \$625/ month or less; and
- d. Student is receiving full-time formal education at a mainstream primary/secondary school/Junior College/ Centralised Institute/ Mixed Level/ specialised school/independent school/specialised independent school/ MOEdesignated full-time Madrasahs; and
- e. Is not concurrently receiving school pocket money from another STSPMF disbursing agency or receiving monthly school pocket money from other schemes, excluding MOE FAS; and
- f. Has not been a STSPMF beneficiary for 24 months for the whole schooling years of primary and secondary school and 48 months for post-secondary school.

Successful applicants will be notified through the school by first week of January 2020.













C. 54th NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION - "OUR SINGAPORE"

National Day marks our separation from Malaysia, and our emergence as an independent country in the community of nations. This year's National Day Celebration marks the 54th anniversary of our independence.

- □ Ensure your child / ward brings his / her school Ezlink card / library card on 2 & 3 September 2019 if your child / ward is an existing member of NLB
- ☐ Pay the fines (if any) in your child's / ward's library account
 For your convenience, the following payment options are available:
 - By CashCard, NETs or ez-link via the Book Borrowing Stations and Reservation Lockers at all Public Libraries.
 - Online payment via Paypal when you log in at our website www.nlb.gov.sg or via the NLB Mobile App.
- Return the books in your child's / ward's account before the Books 2 Go activity
- □ If your child / ward has lost his / her school Ezlink card, please report the loss at any public library and make a new library card. (Note: A fee of \$1.00 applies for a new library card.)

Kindly ensure that the NLB books borrowed in the school on 2 & 3 September 2019 are <u>returned</u> to any public <u>library</u> by the <u>due date</u> that is indicated on the loan receipt.

In addition, you are encouraged to sign up for myLibrary, a suite of enhanced e-services. With the myLibrary ID, you will be able to view your child's / ward's borrowing record as well as activate the free reminder service. The reminder service will prompt you to return the books which your child / ward has borrowed, on time.
