## Terms and Conditions for student's participation

The Judges' decisions on the results are final. No correspondence or appeal shall be entertained. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change any of the rules and regulations without prior notice. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to disqualify any participants if he/she does not adhere to any of the below rules and regulations.

- Once the schedule for audition date & time is confirmed, there should be no changes thereafter unless for valid reason/s (i.e. students cannot attend audition session without parental consent)
- The audition performance should not exceed 1 min in duration.
- Performance must be appropriate for school. No explicit, provocative, or suggestive lyrics, gestures or attires will be accepted.
- Audition entries submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

# **D. STUDENT LOCKERS**

As part of student well-being, the school has installed individual lockers for all students outside their respective classrooms. The students can start to use these lockers with immediate effect. The lockers will help students in learning the importance of ownership, responsibility and security and this will help alleviate the concerns of heavy school bags. # E. P6 CHALLENGE CAMP 2023

The school has specially organized a 2-day **non-residential** camp at two different venues for our P6 cohort in Term 1 Week 7. The P6 Challenge Camp aims to give students the opportunity to develop G.R.I.T. (Growth Mindset, Resilience, Independence, and Teamwork) qualities, acquire outdoor education skills, forge camaraderie, and build positive relationships by working in groups.

Students can look forward to exciting activities such as kayaking, knots and lashes, team-bonding challenges, and an Amazing Race where they will need to work together and think out of the box.
