#### No Right Turn

Please refrain from parking your vehicle along Bukit Purmei Avenue as it poses a danger to other road users and is also a hindrance to traffic flow. We seek your co-operation and understanding to alleviate the inconvenience to the Bukit Purmei Avenue community, caused by illegal parking along the road, leading to traffic congestion.

#### F. HOME-BASED LEARNING FOR P1 AND P2 STUDENTS IN LIEU OF OLYMPIC FESTIVAL
