In our continuous efforts to strengthen the school's safety and security, the following have been implemented. We seek the understanding of all parents/ guardians to adhere to the structures and processes we have put in place, for the enhanced safety and security of our students and staff.

A1 SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES & VISITOR MANAGEMENT

A2 DESIGNATED WAITING AREA FOR PARENTS/ GUARDIANS DURING SCHOOL DISMISSAL

P1 parents/ guardians are to produce the P1 dismissal pass and proceed to wait at the waiting area located in the school canteen for their children/ wards during dismissal. Unauthorized personnel are not allowed beyond this designated waiting area. P2- P6 parents/ guardians are to wait at the waiting area nearer the school gate for their children's/ ward's dismissal. We seek your support and understanding to maintain a safe distance and to leave the school ground immediately after picking up your child/ ward.

A4 SEASON PARKING IN RMPS

All carpark lots in the school have been reserved for season parking holders. Due to limited lots available, the school may not be able to provide sufficient visitor parking to parents. The school seeks your cooperation to park at Blk 108 and Blk 112, and enter the school via the Bukit Purmei Avenue side gate and proceed immediately to the Security Guard Post for visitor's registration. We appreciate your understanding.















A5 TRAFFIC MATTERS

Students Alighting Along Lower Delta Road at Arrival

If you drive your child(ren)/ ward(s) to school in the morning, please do not allow him/ her/ them to alight along the Lower Delta Road and/ or Bukit Purmei Avenue as it poses a danger to him/ her/ them and other road users and is a hindrance to smooth traffic flow. Please drive into RMPS via Bukit Purmei Avenue so that your child(ren)/ ward(s) can alight at the foyer safely. We seek your understanding and cooperation to ensure his/ her/ their safety and well-being, as well as to be socially responsible by playing your part to prevent traffic congestion along Lower Delta Road and Bukit Purmei Avenue.

Strictly For Drop Off And Pick Up At The School Fover

To facilitate the smooth flow of vehicles driving into RMPS for students to alight at arrival and for parents to fetch him/ her/ them at dismissal, please note of the "STRICTLY FOR DROP OFF AND PICK UP" signs at the foyer. If you drive your child(ren)/ ward(s) to school, please ensure that his/ her/ their bags are with them so that he/ she/ they can alight quickly on his/ her/ their own, at the foyer. This will ease traffic congestion leading into RMPS and minimise the wait time of other parents who are also driving their child(ren)/ ward(s) to school. Similarly, if you drive to school to fetch your child(ren)/ ward(s) at the foyer, he/ she/ they should board the vehicle quickly and minimise the wait time of other parents who also drive to school to fetch their child(ren)/ ward(s).

No Right Turn

Please take note of the "NO RIGHT TURN" sign in front of the school. Parents/ Guardians are not allowed to make a right turn upon exit from the school on Mondays to Fridays from 6.45 am to 7.45 am.

Parking Along Bukit Purmei Avenue at Dismissal

If you fetch your child(ren)/ ward(s) after school by car, please park at the HDB carparks at Blk 108 and Blk 112, and walk to the Bukit Purmei side gate to wait for him/ her/ them. Alternatively, you may time your arrival after 1.45 pm so that you can drive into RMPS after the school buses have left. Please refrain from parking your vehicles along Bukit Purmei Avenue as it poses a danger to other road users and is also a hindrance to smooth traffic flow. We seek your co-operation and understanding to alleviate the inconvenience to the Bukit Purmei Avenue community, caused by illegal parking along the road, leading to traffic congestion.

A6 EARLY DISMISSAL OF STUDENTS

If there is a need for your child(ren)/ ward(s) to be dismissed early from school for valid reasons, please inform his/ her/ their Form Teachers at least one day in advance and make arrangements for him/ her/ them to be fetched by an adult. Please note that the school will not allow your child(ren)/ ward(s) to go home on his/ her/ their own before dismissal, in the absence of an accompanying adult. The adult designated to fetch him/ her/ them must sign him/ her/ them out at the General Office.

D1 P3 CCA SELECTION 2020

CCA is an integral part of the co-curriculum as it provides opportunities for holistic growth and development. It serves as a platform for students to discover their interests and talents, and fuel their passion for a particular lifelong activity.

In Radin Mas Primary School, the CCAs are based on these domains: Physical Sports, Clubs & Societies, Visual & Performing Arts and Uniformed Groups. Each domain focuses on the development of specific knowledge, skills and values, and has its own objectives. Through sustained participation, students are able to progressively develop the CCA-specific knowledge, skills and values, engage in social interaction, and reinforce their sense of identity and belonging to the school. It is therefore imperative for your child/ward to attend CCAs regularly as it is seen as a core school programme.

The CCA registration period will be from **Mon**, **08.06.2020** to **Fri**, **12.06.2020** and all P3 students must indicate 3 CCA choices via this URL link **https://go.gov.sg/rmpsccaselection** or you may scan the QR code. The allocation of CCA will be subjected to the availability of each CCA and also your child's/ ward's choices. Your child/ ward will be informed of the outcome of the allocation of CCA latest by **Fri**, **19.06.2020**.

School-based assessments are platforms to inform and enhance teaching and learning. These assessments provide opportunities for teachers to assess the pupils' ability to apply their learning. With the cancellation of Term 2 Weighted Assessments (WA) this year, the school has made adjustments to Term 3 WA and Term 4 SA2.

E3 REMOVAL OF MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE TOPICS FOR PRIMARY 3 SEMESTRAL ASSESSMENT 2 (SA2)

In light of the impact that the extended Circuit Breaker period has on curriculum time and to further allay concerns and anxiety about catching up with the curriculum, a few topics will be removed from the Semestral Assessments this year. While these topics may not be tested in SA2, they will still be taught during post-exam period.

E4 SCHOOL EXAMINATION POLICY FOR SEMESTRAL ASSESSMENTS

The following table indicates the various codes which can be printed on the Result Slips of students who are absent for any component/ paper during the examination.

In the interest of the entire student population of RMPS, we appeal to parents of students who are covered by Medical Certificates, **not to send them to school** to sit for their examination. Students who are unwell will **NOT** be allowed to sit for the examination even if they turned up in school. Parents will be asked to take them home. The school will consider the examination results of students who sit for their written examination papers while on Medical Leave null and void. There will be **no re-test** for students who are absent from any written component(s)/ paper(s) during the examination. **The school will only conduct a makeup for students who missed their EL, MT, FEL, FMT oral examination.** A copy of the examination paper(s) missed (except Oral & Listening Comprehension Papers) will be given to them for reference/ practice at home.
