(b) P2: Integrated Learning Trail to Kok Fah Technological Farm

The P2 integrated trail provides students with the opportunity to have experiential and authentic learning at a farm. Students will have a guided tour of the Greenhouse, learn about traditional and modern farming methods and observe the harvesting of Aloe Vera. The students will have a hands on experience of harvesting their own hydroponics vegetables and potting of microgreens. The students will also gain a better understanding of where their vegetables come from.

As part of the visit, students will be provided with an Aloe Vera Jelly for their snack break. Please note that the Aloe Vera Jelly is made with Aloe Vera grown from the farm. It is all natural and no preservatives have been added. Please indicate in the notes section if you would like your child/ward to **opt out** from having the jelly.

Please note that Safe Management Measures will be put in place for the visit. There will only be one class visiting the farm on each day. The Greenhouse, briefing area and the activity area will be cordoned off and there will be no intermingling with the public. The students will be in their masks at all times. They will also be split up into smaller groups for the various activities at the farm.

F. PRIMARY 3 CAMP

As part of the school's Learning for Life Programme - G.R.I.T @ RMPS – Growth Mindset.Resilience.Independence.
