2021 PRIMARY SCHOOL LEAVING EXAMINATION (PSLE) (For P5 students) APPLICATION FOR ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS (AA) FOR STUDENTS WITH LEARNING / PHYSICAL DISABILITIES (Mdm Malar Vizhi, YH-Upper Primary)

In the PSLE, students with learning or physical disabilities may apply for AA during the examination.

Learning Disabilities

Students with learning disabilities (e.g. Dyslexia, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism Spectrum Disorder, etc) who wish to apply for Access Arrangements (e.g. extra-time) for the **2021 PSLE** are required to submit their applications through the school to the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB).

The application must be accompanied by a copy of a psychological / professional report that:

- states clearly the specific learning disability, as diagnosed by qualified professionals*;
- is current, i.e. the evaluation of learning needs arising from the disability should be completed within three years prior to the date of the PSLE (older reports should also be submitted if they are referred to in the updated report);
- provides relevant information pertaining to medical, developmental and educational history;
- describes the comprehensive testing and techniques used to arrive at the diagnosis, including evaluation dates and test
 results with subtest scores from measures such as cognitive ability, academic achievement, and information processing;
- describes the functional limitations supported by the test results;
- describes the specific AA requested, and provides a rationale for the student's need for the specified AA.
- *Note: Professionals qualified to make the evaluation include educational psychologists, child/clinical psychologists, psychiatrists, occupational therapists and speech and language therapists. You may consult the MOE Psychologist if you require clarifications on psychological/professional reports.

Physical Disabilities

Students with physical disabilities (e.g. Hearing Impairment, Visual Impairment, Speech Impairment, and physical impairment such as Cerebral Palsy, etc) who wish to apply for AA for the **2021 PSLE** are also required to submit their applications together with a copy of a medical report from qualified professionals (which include registered medical practitioners, occupational therapists and speech and language therapists). The medical report must state the following:

- when the disability was diagnosed;
- how the disability will affect the candidate's performance during examination; and
- the type of AA(s) that is/are required by the candidate during examination

Please note that a medical certificate (MC) from a doctor is insufficient.

Please note that the AA requests for the following are not allowed:

- Extra time for the PSLE Listening comprehension (LC) examination
- Reader for language subjects (Standard / Foundation English & Mother Tongue).

Annotation of Examination Certificates and Results Slips

On the PSLE certificates, the titles of subjects which were taken under AA would be annotated with a symbol. Explanations for the symbols are provided on the certificates.

The following two annotation symbols would be used:

- (a) Exemption Symbol (#)
 - 'The candidate was exempted from satisfying the full range of assessment objectives in this subject. Details may be obtained from the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board.'
- (b) Access Arrangement Symbol (+)
 - 'The candidate sat for the subject under access arrangements. Details may be obtained from the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board.'

Parents who wish to apply for any of the above Access Arrangements for the 2021 PSLE are to submit the relevant documents to your child's 2021 form teacher by Wed, 06.01.2021.

GET A MEASURING TAPE

Kindly choose the inches or the CM side depending on the size chart



SHIRT MEASUREMENT

Shoulders and Chest measurement
Measure the shoulders from one end to the other.
If the shoulder is 15°, the shirt size should be size
32, If you want a larger size, choose the next bigger size. The sizing is calculated:(Shoulders x 2)+2



PANTS/ SKIRT MEASUREMENT

Waist Measurement

Measure the area where you usually wear your pants/skirt. For example, you wear at the hip area, kindly measure at the hip area. If the measured size is 31°, you can round up and choose size 32°.

The length of the pants/skirt is standard, alteration of the length is at your discretion. However, once altered, no exchange is allowed.



PE ATTIRE MEASUREMENT

Choose the CM side on the measuring tape. PE Shirt.

Measure from shoulder to shoulder and follow the sizing chart.

PE Shorts

Measure the waist. All our PE shorts comes with an elastic waist band that is stretchable,

With effect from January 2020, the annual bus fares will be payable over 9 months in a school academic year. The collection months are January, February, March, April, May, July, August, September, and October. There will be no fees collection for the month of June, November and December.

The benefits of the 9-month payment schedule are:

- No advance payment is required for the month of June, November and December
- Total bus fare is paid equally over 9 months

The school will publish the fares quoted in the MOE Information Notice Board for School Bus Services (IBSB) website at https://schadmsvc.moe.gov.sg/moeibsb/ for viewing by parents. Parents can also access the IBSB website through the 'Info for School Bus Services' button on MOE Internet Homepage (at http://www.moe.gov.sg/).

To register your child for our transport service in the AY2021, do complete the registration form via the QR code attached. Kindly be assured that your details will be kept confidential and Gek Teck Transport Service will only be using the information accordance to our privacy policy.
