F. P5 IMMUNIZATION PROGRAMME AND P2 HEALTH SCREENING BY SCHOOL HEALTH SERVICE (Ms Gracia Tye, Admin Manager)

Doctors and nurses from School Health Service will be visiting our school from Mon, 15.11.2021 to Wed, 17.11.2021 to conduct immunization for our P5 students and health screening for P2 students. Parents/ guardians are to submit their child's/ward's latest medical information and provide consent for immunization/health screening through the online portal via https://childconsent.hpb.gov.sg, by using your SingPass. Students are to submit their health booklet to the class Form Teacher by Mon, 08.11.2021. Those who have lost their health booklets may purchase new health booklets from the General Office at \$1.50 per health booklet. Students are to be in PE attire on the immunization/health screening day.

G. UPDATES TO PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AND OVERSEAS TRAVEL

(Ms Mary Goh, Vice-Principal (Admin))

From 11.10.2021, MOH will issue 7-day Health Risk Warning (HRW) to students in close contact with confirmed COVID-19 case. Such students may return to school during the 7 days if they continue to be well and have a negative Antigen Rapid Test (ART) result prior to leaving home.

Parents are to alert the school if their children or any of their family members are issued the Isolation Order (IO) and Health Risk Warning (HRW) by MOH, including school holidays.

Parents who have changed their travel plan(s) after declaration are to submit a new travel declaration for the updated travel destination via Parents Gateway (PG) or inform the school for cancellation of travel plan(s). Please refer to the travel advisory which has been disseminated to the parents via Parents Gateway on 26.10.2021.

Students should practise good personal hygiene both in school and at home. Students who are not well should not report to school and should follow MOH's testing regime where applicable.

We seek parents' support to exercise personal and social responsibility to make Radin Mas Primary a safe environment for all our students and staff.

2022 PRIMARY SCHOOL LEAVING EXAMINATION (PSLE) APPLICATION FOR ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS (AA) FOR STUDENTS WITH LEARNING / PHYSICAL DISABILITIES

(Mdm Malar Vizhi, YH-Upper Primary)

In the PSLE, students with learning or physical disabilities may apply for AA during the examination.

Learning Disabilities

Students with learning disabilities (e.g. Dyslexia, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Autism Spectrum Disorder, etc) who wish to apply for Access Arrangements (e.g. extra-time) for the **2022 PSLE** are required to submit their applications through the school to the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB).

The application must be accompanied by a copy of a psychological / professional report that:

- states clearly the specific learning disability, as diagnosed by qualified professionals*;
- is current, i.e. the evaluation of learning needs arising from the disability should be completed **within three years** prior to the date of the PSLE (older reports should also be submitted if they are referred to in the updated report);
- provides relevant information pertaining to medical, developmental and educational history;
- describes the comprehensive testing and techniques used to arrive at the diagnosis, including evaluation dates and test results with subtest scores from measures such as cognitive ability, academic achievement, and information processing;
- describes the functional limitations supported by the test results;
- describes the specific AA requested, and provides a rationale for the student's need for the specified AA.

*Note: Professionals qualified to make the evaluation include educational psychologists, child/clinical psychologists, psychiatrists, occupational therapists and speech and language therapists. You may consult the MOE Psychologist if you require clarifications on psychological/professional reports.

Physical Disabilities

Students with physical disabilities (e.g. Hearing Impairment, Visual Impairment, Speech Impairment, and physical impairment such as Cerebral Palsy, etc) who wish to apply for Access AA for the **2022 PSLE** are also required to submit their applications together with a copy of a medical report from qualified professionals (which include registered medical practitioners, occupational therapists and speech and language therapists). The medical report must state the following:

- when the disability was diagnosed;
- · how the disability will affect the candidate's performance during examination; and
- the type of AA(s) that is/are required by the candidate during examination

Please note that a medical certificate (MC) from a doctor is insufficient.

Please note that the AA requests for the following are not allowed:

- Extra time for the PSLE Listening comprehension (LC) examination
- Reader for language subjects (Standard / Foundation English & Mother Tongue).

Annotation of Examination Certificates and Results Slips

On the PSLE certificates, the titles of subjects which were taken under AA would be annotated with a symbol. Explanations for the symbols are provided on the certificates.

The following two annotation symbols would be used:

(a) Exemption Symbol (#)

'The candidate was exempted from satisfying the full range of assessment objectives in this subject. Details may be obtained from the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board.'

(b) Access Arrangement Symbol (+)

'The candidate sat for the subject under access arrangements. Details may be obtained from the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board.'

Parents who wish to apply for any of the above Access Arrangements for the **2022 PSLE** are to submit the relevant documents to your child's 2022 form teacher by **4.1.2022**.
