Dear Parents/Guardians,

Full Home-Based Learning (HBL)

- In line with the Multi-Ministry Taskforce's latest efforts to further enhance safe distancing measures, schools will step up their safe distancing measures. From 8 April 2020, all MOE schools will shift to full Home-Based Learning (HBL) till 4 May 2020.
- 2. During the period of full HBL, schools will provide instructions and support for your child to access a range of both online and hardcopy HBL resources so that learning can continue. The school will be sending out the weekly HBL packages to parents via Parents Gateway every Friday. To distribute the system load and provide better user experience for online learning, students are encouraged to adhere to the recommended HBL timetable. However, for families with a few children at home sharing a device, your children could take turns to complete the online assignments anytime within the day. A copy of the HBL timetable will also be uploaded on the school website. Kindly refer to **Annex A** (HBL for 8 April 2020) and **Annex B** (HBL for 9 April 2020) for this week's HBL packages.
- If your child needs learning or emotional support, he/she can approach our teachers and other school personnel such as our allied educators and school counsellors, who will continue to work from home or from school. Our teachers will also be in regular contact with you and your child.
- 4. All school-based Mid-Year Examinations will be cancelled. However, national examinations, including the Primary School Leaving Examinations will proceed as planned and with the necessary precautionary measures in place. Our teachers will continue to monitor the progress of your child through HBL assignments.
- 5. Student care centres will suspend their general services during this period. If you are working in essential services, and are unable to secure alternative care arrangements, you may approach the school for assistance.
- 6. Please ensure that your child stays at home and continues to observe good hygiene practices such as washing their hands frequently with soap. If he/she feels unwell, please seek medical attention promptly and inform his/her form teacher if he/she displays any fever or flu-like symptoms.
- 7. We plan to resume classes on 5 May 2020. MOE will continue to closely monitor the COVID-19 situation to assess if HBL needs to be extended. We urge you to rely on official sources of information and not to circulate any unconfirmed information.
