- Acquisition of key content
- Immersive language environment with activities and games to encourage learning

#### HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT CHILD IN LEARNING

#### LISTENING & SPEAKING

- Increase the exposure time of using MTL at home
- Converse in MT with child
- Tap on ICT resources to learn (MOE resources)
- Watch educational TV programmes, movies, news etc
- Listen to radio programmes

#### **READING**

- Revise the textbook with your child (words, oral vocabulary, sentence structures)
- Get your child to read aloud the P3 texts with you
- Use 5W+1H to strike a conversation with the child about the text read
- Read MT storybooks

#### HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT CHILD IN LEARNING

#### WRITING

- Read MT story books/ e-books
- Bring your child to the library to borrow books
- Write card/ journal/ short notes
- Use of dictionary/ e-dictionary to encourage independent learning

#### **TEACHER-PARENT PARTNERSHIP**

Make Mother Tongue a Living Language.

Create an environment for the child to apply what he/she has learnt in daily life.
