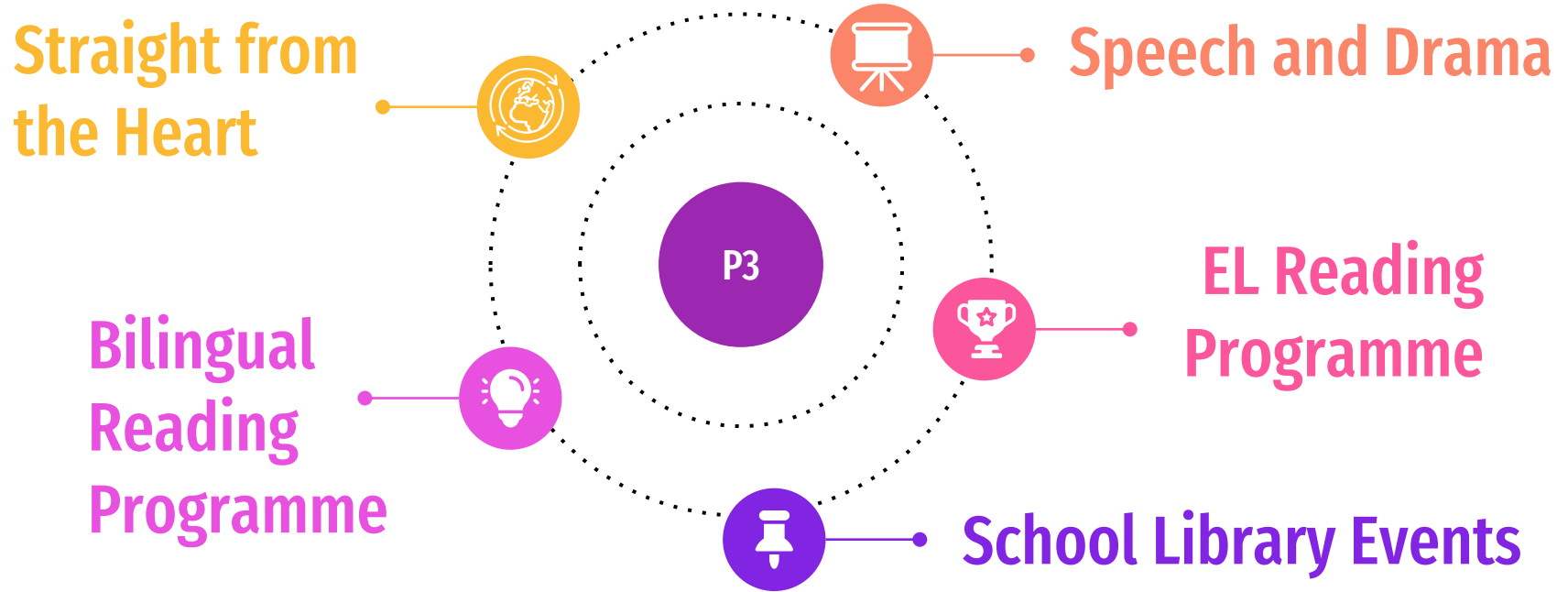

Suggestions on How You Can Help

Components	You can get your child to...
Oral	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practice reading aloud in front of parents/family members• Share opinions related to daily happenings/current affairs with parents/family members
Paper 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Put into practice the writing skills taught by teachers• Use newly-learnt vocabulary words intentionally (e.g. word bank book/ word wall)• Master the spelling of commonly misspelled words• Find opportunities to write creatively (e.g. What if you fell into a vat of Kaya?)• Build writing stamina (e.g. journalling)
Paper 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Be aware of his/her areas of strengths and weaknesses• Note the common errors for the various sections• Learn the vocabulary words and take the chance to learn the meaning of the options presented

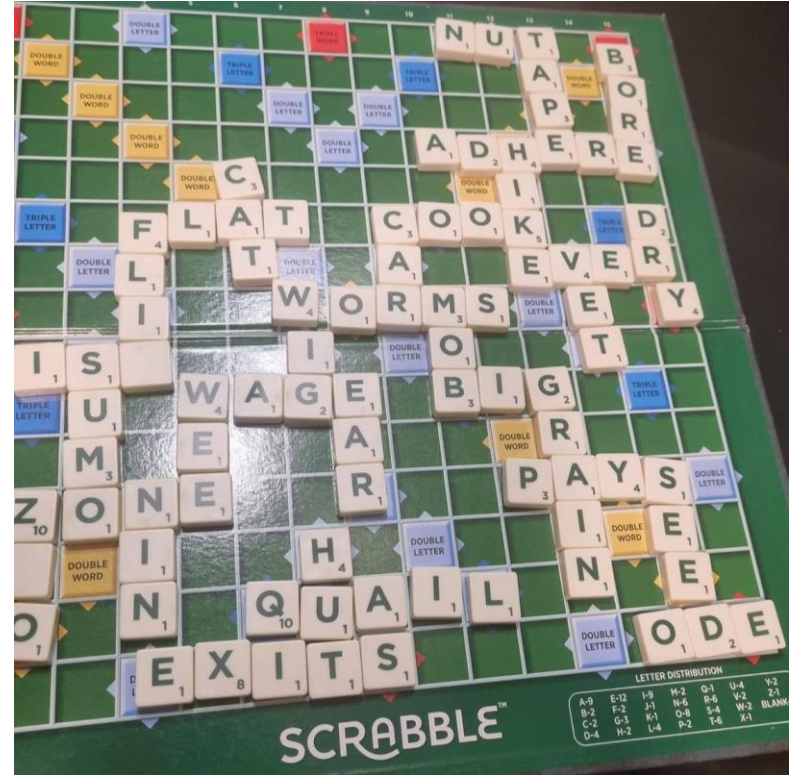
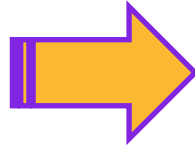
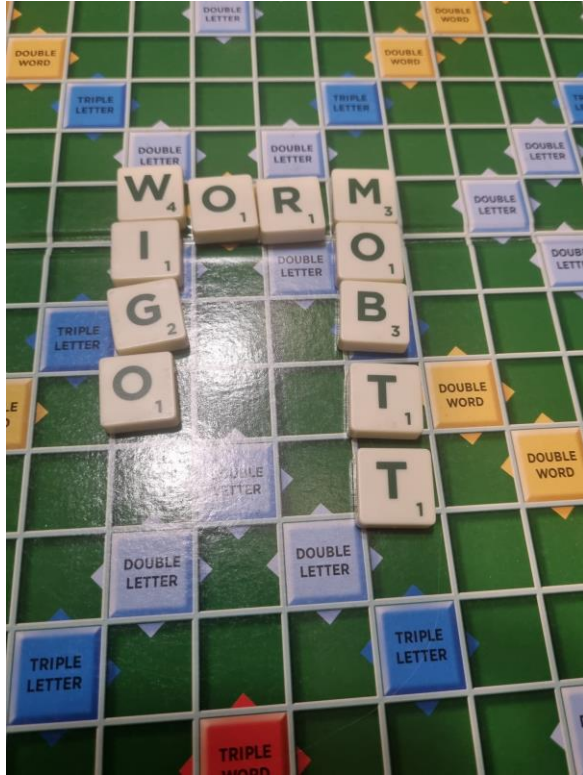
