A. Primary 6 School-Based Assessment for 2023

Radin Mas Primary School (RMPS) continues to provide different checkpoints in the form of weighted and non-weighted assessments to ensure a holistic education for our students. Qualitative and quantitative information gathered from these assessments allow teachers to ascertain the mastery level of students for the topics taught and timely intervention to be carried out to help students close learning gaps, should there be areas of concern.

Non-weighted assessments are conducted regularly to provide feedback on students' learning progress and support them in achieving the intended learning outcomes. These tasks are formative and include day-to-day class work, various assignments and teacher observations.

The following table indicates the type of assessment and the percentage of marks apportioned to each term/semester for the core subjects.

B. School Examination Policy

The well-being of our students is of utmost importance. In the interest of the entire student population of RMPS, we appeal to parents not to send your child to school to sit for their examination if he / she is unwell / on medical leave (i.e. with a medical certificate).

The following table indicates the various codes which can be printed on the Result Slips of students who are absent for any component/ paper during the examination.

Code	Reasons For Absence	School Action
AB	Absence without a valid reason	Score of '0' is entered for component/ paper missed
MC	Absence with Medical Certificate	Component(s)/ paper(s) missed will not be used for the computation of Overall Results.
VR	Absence with valid reason (Official supporting documents must be submitted; letter of excuse from parent will NOT be accepted)	<u>These students will not be disadvantaged in any way.</u> Copies of the examination paper(s) missed will also be given to them for reference / practice at home.

Students who are unwell **will not** be allowed to sit for the examination even if they turn up in school, and parents will be asked to take them home. The school will consider the examination results of students who sit for their written examination papers while on Medical Leave null and void. There will be **no re-test** for students who are absent from any written component(s) / paper(s) during the examination. The school will only conduct a make-up for students who missed their Oral Examination.



C. SCHEDULE AND SCOPE OF TOPICS TESTED

1. Timed-Practice

The Timed-Practice for the four core subjects will be conducted between 02.05.2023 to 19.05.2023. The schedule will be sent at a later date.

2. Preliminary Examination

The Preliminary Examination (Oral) will be conducted on 05.07.2023 and 06.07.2023. The Preliminary Examination (Written) will be conducted between 02.08.2023 to 24.08.2023. The schedule will be sent at a later date. All topics taught from P3-P6 will be tested.
