## 2021 Primary 5 Weighted Assessment (Term 3)

Dear Parents/Guardian,

With reference to an earlier circular sent on 3 February 2021, the school has shared the removal of Mid-Year Examinations and the introduction of Weighted Assessment and Non-Weighted Assessment as Formative Assessments for Primary 5. This move will free up valuable curriculum time for the school to customize learning for deeper learning.

This notification shares with you more information on the Primary 5 Weighted Assessment which will take place in Week 8 and 9 this term.

## (A) School Assessment Weighting 2021

The following table indicates the percentage of marks apportioned to each term/semester for the core subjects.

## (C) Management of Absences for Weighted Assessment

The well-being of our students is of utmost importance. Parents <u>should not</u> send their children to school to sit for the weighted assessment under the following circumstances:

- If your child is unwell / on medical leave (i.e. with a medical certificate)
- If your child is issued Approved Absence (AA), Stay Home Notice (SHN), Quarantine Order (QO), LOA (Confirmed), LOA (QO) or LOA (SHN)
- If there are any household members who are:
  - unwell with flu-like symptoms (of age 6 and above),
  - on Stay Home Notice (SHN), Quarantine Order (QO), LOA (Confirmed), LOA (QO), LOA (SHN) or
  - awaiting the outcome of a mandatory swab test.
- If your child/any household members have received a Health Risk Warning SMS from MOH.

















Students <u>will not</u> be allowed to sit for the weighted assessment even if they turn up in school, and parents will be requested to bring your child home or seek medical attention. There will be <u>no re-test</u> for students who are absent.

The following table indicates the various codes which can be printed on the Result Slips of students who are absent for any Weighted Assessments.
