B. UPDATED SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURE (SMM)

From **29 August 2022**, mask-wearing is not mandatory for both indoor and outdoor settings. However, mask wearing will continue on board school buses.

Students should continue their personal hygiene habits, e.g. hand washing, and keep common areas clean by wiping down surfaces where necessary. Students should be socially responsible. Those who are unwell should stay at home and seek medical consultation if necessary.













Those who are close contacts of an infected case should follow **Protocol 3** – take an ART self-test and make sure they test negative before going out over the next 5 days.

Even as mask-wearing is removed in most settings, individuals are encouraged to wear masks when in crowded places, or when visiting or interacting with vulnerable persons or unwell.

The school will be conducting Home-based Learning for P1 to P5 students during PSLE Listening Comprehension Examinations on Friday 16.09.2022. All P1 to P5 students are not required to report to school on 16.09.2022 and are to complete the home-based learning assignments.

The objectives of the Home-based Learning are:

- to inculcate independent learning habits in our students;
- to empower students with the necessary skills to use technology for self-directed learning;

- to prepare students in the event of unexpected school closure due to national emergencies.

Assignments may be in the form of digital (e.g. Student Learning Space) and/ or non-digital prints (e.g. Workbooks, Worksheets, etc.)

All learning tasks will be published on the school's website as well as uploaded onto the Parent Gateway.
