# Follow-up and Consequences

- The school recognises that our students are children who are developing their empathy, self-responsibility, and self-discipline.
- Students who commit offences will be responsible for their actions. Every effort will be taken to educate and help them to learn from their mistakes.



# Consequences for Serious Offences

- When students commit more serious offences such as cheating, stealing, being openly defiant or fighting, the school can mete out consequences such as detention or suspension.
- Serious offences may also warrant a drop in the student's conduct grade. A student's conduct grade, awarded at the end of each semester. It is a form of recognition for good behaviour, or a reflection of a student's poor behaviour.



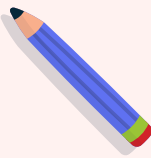

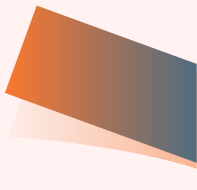
# Edusave Merit Bursary
