SETUP GIRO STANDING ORDER

- Apply GIRO to enjoy the hassle-free and convenient payment arrangement.
- You may do so through the service tab on Parents Gateway.
- Your child will not need to bring additional cash to school monthly.
- GIRO arrangement can be used to pay fees, enrichment programmes and charges, national examination fees (if applicable) and for disbursement/refund purposes (e.g. payment of school awards or refund of excess paid).

MOE will update you on your application outcome via email during the following periods:

Date of Submission	Date of email update
Submit by 25 th of month (Feb to Oct)	First week of following month
Submit by 25 th of month (Nov to Jan)	From Jan to first week of Feb

EDUSAVE ACCOUNT



All Singapore Citizen students will have an Edusave account automatically opened for them and receive a yearly contribution.



Parents can sign up for the Edusave standing order to use your child's Edusave account to pay 2nd-tier miscellaneous fees and enrichment programmes to reduce your out-of-pocket expenses.



From 1 January 2024, the standard miscellaneous fee and second-tier miscellaneous fee will be merged into a single miscellaneous fee.

School Level	Current Standard Miscellaneous Fee	Current Maximum Second-Tier Miscellaneous Fee	New Single-Tier Miscellaneous Fee (from 1 Jan 2024)
Primary	\$6.50	\$6.50	\$13

- Parents may use Edusave to pay for the single-tier miscellaneous fee.

MOE Financial Assistance Scheme

The Ministry of Education provides financial assistance to Singaporean students from our Government and Government-Aided Schools who need financial assistance for their studies.
