D. PRIMARY SCHOOL TRANSFER SERVICE

The aim of the Primary School Transfer Service is to centrally facilitate the transfer of Primary 1 to Primary 5 school students, who are Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (SPR) and have relocated to another address, to schools nearer to their new residences.

The student will have to report to the new school by the end of the reporting period to complete the school transfer. Parents'/ Guardians' NRIC must be updated with the new residential address when reporting to the new school. If students decide not to accept the school offered, or miss the reporting deadline, he/ she will remain in the current school. To minimise the disruption to the child's studies and ease their integration into the new school, please plan ahead and apply for the transfer during the period nearest to when you intend to change your address.

E. NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATION 2020 – “TOGETHER, A STRONGER SINGAPORE”

National Day marks our separation from Malaysia, and our emergence as an independent country in the community of nations. This year's National Day Celebration marks the 55th anniversary of our independence.

This year, the theme for the celebration is "Together, A Stronger Singapore", which is a rallying call to Singaporeans to play our part to push forward and determine Singapore's future, in spite of the difficulties and crises. "Together" refers to Singaporeans uniting as one people, brought closer in bonds of compassion and kindness, while "A Stronger Singapore" signifies our determination to emerge from the crisis stronger as a nation, with our best days ahead of us.

As part of the celebration, we have prepared an Observance ceremony, as well as a series of classroom-based activities for our students on the morning of Fri, 07.08.2020. Lessons will resume from 9.45 am onwards. **Please note that curriculum hours are as per normal, with the same staggered dismissal timings for Fridays.**

Students are encouraged to wear a red T-shirt together with their PE shorts or pinafore and school shoes. Otherwise students may come in the usual PE attire.

F. HOME-BASED LEARNING (For P1 to P5 students)

The school will be conducting Home-based Learning for Primary 1 to Primary 5 students during PSLE Oral on Thu, 13.08.2020 and Fri, 14.08.2020. All Primary 1 to Primary 5 students are not required to report to school on 13.08.2020 and 14.08.2020 and are to complete the home-based learning assignments.

The objectives of the Home-based Learning are:

- To inculcate independent learning habits in our students;
- To empower students with the necessary skills to use technology for self-directed learning;
- To prepare students in the event of unexpected school closure due to national emergencies.

Assignments may be in the form of digital (e.g. Student Learning Space) and/ or non-digital prints (e.g. Workbooks, Worksheets, etc.). All learning tasks will be published on the school's website as well as uploaded onto the Student Learning Space (SLS).

Advisory Notice

Dear Parents/Guardians,

PARKING REGULATIONS ALONG BUKIT PURMEI AVENUE OUTSIDE RADIN MAS PRIMARY SCHOOL (RMPS)

Our office has received feedback regarding vehicles parking indiscriminately near RMPS, along Bukit Purmei Avenue. While we understand the need of parents/guardians to pick up their children expeditiously, such inconsiderate parking has unfortunately caused inconvenience, obstruction and danger to other road users.

For the safety of the members of public, we would like to urge all drivers to exercise care and consideration by **not parking** at these critical areas:

- I 6 metres within a junction;
- II 9 metres within a bus stop;
- III At entrances or exits of any premises
- IV At taxi stand &
- V At signalised pedestrian crossing

Under the Road Traffic Act, any of the above acts constitutes to a parking offence. Upon receiving feedback of such occurrences, LTA will take enforcement action against vehicles found parking indiscriminately. Please be reminded not to arrive too early to wait for your child during school dismissal.

Let us play our part to make the road safe for all road users.
