### C. STUDENT LOCKERS

(Mr Simon Lim, OM)

The school has installed individual lockers for all students for all levels outside their respective classrooms. The students can start to use these lockers with effect from **Thu, 01.04.2021**. The lockers will help students in learning the importance of ownership, responsibility, security and hygiene when they start to manage their personal lockers. Lockers provide students with a safe and convenient place to store items they don't immediately require, retrieving them as and when needed. This will help to reduce instances of forgotten school materials or problems of health issues related to carrying heavy bags. The school seek the parents' support to educate our students on proper management of lockers assigned to them. Students are to provide their own locks for their lockers.



**D. DELIVERY OR COLLECTION OF PERSONAL BELONGINGS DURING OR AFTER SCHOOL HOURS**

Ensuring the upkeep of personal belongings is a key strand in developing personal responsibility. To further cultivate and nurture this to be a personal habit, RMPS has in place a non-delivery practice of non-essential items to your child(ren) and ward(s) during curriculum hours. However, we recognize that some items, eg wallets, spectacles or medication, are critical for our students.

Therefore, the school will only facilitate delivery of critical items if necessary. In addition, students will only be able to retrieve items left in the classrooms on the next school day.

We will remind teachers not to ask students to call home and request for the delivery of items they have forgotten to bring to school. Together, teachers and parents must stress to the students that they must take personal responsibility and face the consequences of their actions or non-actions. We seek the understanding and cooperation of parents/ guardians to reinforce this important expectation of personal responsibility.

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## RADIN MAS PRIMARY SCHOOL P4 AND P6 SA1 ASSESSMENT MATTERS 2021

### A. SCHOOL ASSESSMENT WEIGHTING 2021

Radin Mas Primary School (RMPS) continues to provide different checkpoints in the form of weighted and non-weighted assessments to ensure a holistic education for our students. Qualitative and quantitative information gathered from these assessments allow teachers to ascertain the mastery level of students for the topics taught and timely intervention to be carried out to help students close learning gaps, should there be areas of concern.

Non-weighted assessments are conducted regularly to provide **feedback** on students' learning progress and support them in achieving the intended learning outcomes. These tasks are formative and include day-to-day class work, various assignments and teacher observations.

Primary 4 and Primary 6 students will have two semestral assessments (SA1 and SA2). The following table indicates the percentage of marks apportioned to each term/semester for the core subjects.

### B. SCHOOL EXAMINATION POLICY FOR SEMESTRAL ASSESSMENTS

The following table indicates the various codes which can be printed on the Result Slips of students who are absent for any component/ paper during the examination.

In the interest of the entire student population of RMPS, we appeal to parents of students who are covered by Medical Certificates, **not to send them to school** to sit for their examination. Students who are unwell will **NOT** be allowed to sit for the examination even if they turned up in school. Parents will be asked to take them home. The school will consider the examination results of students who sit for their written examination papers while on Medical Leave null and void. There will be **no re-test** for students who are absent from any written component(s)/ paper(s) during the examination. **The school will only conduct a makeup for students who missed their EL, MT, FEL, FMT oral examination.** A copy of the examination paper(s) missed (except Oral & Listening Comprehension Papers) will be given to them for reference/ practice at home.
