B. SAFETY MANAGEMENT MEASURES DURING DISMISSAL

In view of the precautionary measures to manage the spread of COVID-19 and to reduce overcrowding, parents/guardians are to adhere strictly to the measures implemented by the school:

- Only P1 parents/guardians are allowed into the school canteen to wait for their child/ward and will be required to take their temperature at the Security Guard Booth before entering the school. Parents are advised to leave the school compound immediately after picking up their child/ward.
- P1 students will be allowed to be dismissed from the **Lower Delta Side gate from Mon, 01.02.2021**. Please inform the Form Teachers if you wish to pick up child/ward at this gate.
- Parents/Guardians for other levels are advised to wait at areas outside the school premises ie nearby void decks, coffeeshops or open areas away from the school to reduce congestion at the various exit points.
- Parents/Guardians are encouraged to meet their child/ward at the Lower Delta Side Gate to further diffuse the crowd at the Bukit Purmei Side Gate.

We appeal to all parents and guardians to also observe the safe distancing measures put in place by the school and seek your support and partnership in making RMPS a safe learning environment for all students and staff.

C. SUPPORT FROM PARENTS/GUARDIANS IN KEEPING THE SCHOOL SAFE

We would like to remind parents/guardians of the following safe management measures that we should all observe:

- If your child/ward is feeling unwell (e.g. sore throat, runny nose, fever or cough), please see a doctor and do not come to school.



- If there are any adult household members (18 years and above) unwell with flu-like symptoms, inform the school and keep your child/ward at home. He/ She will be placed on Approved Absence (AA). Do ensure that the unwell adult household member seeks medical treatment promptly.

For students staying at home, please be assured that the school will continue to support them in their learning. Your vigilance and cooperation are important in keeping our school safe for all. Thank you for your support and understanding.
