### B. HOME-BASED LEARNING (For P1 to P5 students on 18.10.2021 till 21.10.2021) (Mr Saravanan S/O Shanmugam, HOD ICT)

The school will be conducting Home-based Learning for P1 to P5 students during PSLE Marking Exercise on Mon, 18.10.2021 till Thu, 21.10.2021. All P1 to P5 students are not required to report to school on these days and are to complete the home-based learning assignments.

The objectives of the Home-based Learning are:

- To inculcate independent learning habits in our students;
- To empower students with the necessary skills to use technology for self-directed learning;
- To prepare students in the event of unexpected school closure due to national emergencies.

Assignments may be in the form of digital (e.g. Student Learning Space) and/ or non-digital prints (e.g. Workbooks, Worksheets, etc.). All learning tasks will be published on the school's website as well as uploaded onto the Student Learning Space.

### C. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHEME (FAS) 2022

(Ms Gracia Tye, Admin Manager)

The school assists needy students through FAS based on guidelines by Ministry of Education. To qualify, the student must meet the following income criteria.

<b>Students under the FAS will be entitles to the following benefits:</b>	
1. Waiver of school and standard miscellaneous fees 2. Breakfast Fund of \$2.00 per school day 3. Lunch money of \$2.00 for official school late days (i.e. remedial classes and co-curricular activities) 4. Free textbooks and compulsory stationeries 5. Free 2 sets of school uniforms 6. Free 2 sets of PE attire 7. Free 2 pairs of socks 8. Free 1 pair of shoes 9. Transport subsidy – Subsidy of \$180 per annum for public transport or free school bus transport	

Form teachers will be distributing the application forms to students who are currently on FAS. The application form will be given to the eldest child for those with siblings in the school. Parents with children studying in different schools need to complete only one application form for all the school-going Singaporean children and submit it to the school of any child. For new FAS applicants, please obtain the application form from the General Office. Completed forms are to be submitted to the General Office by **Wed, 20.10.2021**.

Students who are currently on FAS are to return their FAS Meal card to the General Office on the last day of the school term to facilitate the renewal of passes for 2022.

#### D. Children's Day Celebration (7.10.2021)

On 7 October 2021, all classes will have online Children's Day celebration from 9 am - 10 am via Zoom, followed by some fun activities planned by PE & Aesthetics Dept.

#### E. SA2 Oral Examinations (For P4 Students)

(Mdm Lee SW Jessie, HOD/MT and Mr Goh Sheow En, HOD/EL)

The P4 SA2 Oral Examinations are rescheduled to the afternoons of Term 4 Week 5, 13/10 (Wed) and 14/10 (Thurs). The Make-Up Oral Examination would be held on 22/10 (Fri), during school hours.

The SA2 Oral Examinations will be conducted on the following days:

\* This is an estimation of the end time. Students are dismissed once they have completed both EL and MT/FMT Oral Examination.

#### Important Notes:

- Safety precautions and social distancing measures will be carried out to ensure the well-being of our students during the Oral Examinations.
- Please make your own transport arrangement for your child/ward if he/she is taking his/her Oral Examination in the afternoon.

Only absentees with valid reasons will be eligible to sit for the make-up Oral Examinations stated above. Supporting documents or medical certificates must be submitted to the respective Form Teachers upon their return to school. Parents' Letters of Excuse will **NOT** be accepted.

#### F. SMM REMINDER

(Ms Mary Goh, Vice-Principal (Admin))

As part of MOE's screening measures, these categories of students should **NOT** report to school:

- a) Students staying in the same household as individuals (6 years old and above) with flu-like symptoms.
- b) Students or their household members having to undergo mandatory testing due to a COVID-19 cluster.
- c) Students or their household members are currently placed on Stay Home Notice, issued Health Risk Warning or under a Quarantine Order.

Parents are to alert the school if their children or any of their family members are issued the above status. Do also check in with the school, if a Health Risk Alert or Phone Surveillance notification is issued.

If students have a household member serving their quarantine order at home, MOH may issue a Stay Order or Letter of Undertaking that prevents the students from leaving their home.

Students should practise good personal hygiene both in school and at home. Students and their household members should seek medical attention immediately if they are unwell with flu-like symptoms (even mild symptoms) and should undergo a COVID-19 swab test. Do remind your child to bring his/her TT tokens and thermometer daily to school.


