The registration for the event has started. To sign-up, students may visit <https://bit.ly/RMPST2022registration> to indicate their interest or request a hardcopy form from their Art or Music teachers before **4<sup>th</sup> February 2022**.

Audition could be done via **one** of the following ways:

1. Submitting a video recording of not more than 1 min in duration to <https://bit.ly/RMPST2022audition>  
*(Note: Singing / wind instrument performance has to be done strictly at home and recorded)*
2. Attending in-person live audition on 03/03/2022 (Thu) or 08/03/2022 (Tue) after school.  
*(Consent form will be given on ParentsGateway for students who have registered, Masked singing and wind instrument performance in school is not allowed due to COVID-19 SMM)*

We encourage all students to participate and register for audition in groups of no more than 5 or individually. We seek your support to help your child register their interest and ensure their performance is appropriate for school.



### Terms and Conditions for student's participation

- The judges' decisions on the results are final.
- Once the schedule for audition date and time is confirmed, there should be no changes thereafter unless for valid reason/s (i.e. students cannot attend audition session without parental consent).
- The audition performance should not exceed 1 min in duration.
- Performance must be appropriate for school. No explicit, provocative or suggestive lyrics, gestures or attires will be accepted.
- Audition entries submitted after the deadline will not be accepted.

### **F. STUDENT LOCKERS**
