B. 2022 PRIMARY ONE (P1) REGISTRATION EXERCISE – PHASE 1 REGISTRATION

The 2022 Primary One (P1) Registration Exercise will be conducted from June to August 2022. The school has sent out a notification on Parents Gateway and emailed to all eligible parents who have a Singapore Citizen (SC) or Permanent Resident (PR) child eligible for Phase 1.

If you have a SC or PR child born between **2 Jan 2016 and 1 Jan 2017 (both dates inclusive)** and the child has a sibling studying in our school and have not received any notification, please submit the online form at <https://go.gov.sg/p1onlinefo> by **Fri, 06.05.2022**. The school will contact you should additional clarifications and / or documents are required.

If your child is non-SC / non-PR and thus not eligible for Phase 1, please submit an online Indication of Interest between Tue, 31.05.2022 and Mon, 06.06.2022 at go.gov.sg/P1reg.

C. PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCE

P1 – P6 Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) will be held online on Thu, 26.05.2022 from 2.15 pm to 5.15 pm and Fri, 27.05.2022 from 8.30 am to 5.00 pm. Students need not report to school for lessons on Fri, 27.05.2022.

We are pleased to invite you to discuss your child's holistic development with the Form and Mother Tongue Teachers through online Zoom meetings or over the phone. The Form Teacher will present updates on behalf of other Subject Teachers. Some of our teachers including Mother Tongue teachers may be teaching more than one level. E. UPDATED SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURE (SMM)

From **26 April 2022**, the following adjustments to the SMM framework will be implemented:

Group Size

- No group size and safe distancing requirements for school activities. This will lead to a resumption of more school activities.

Mask-wearing

- Mask-wearing required indoors as a default.
- Unmasking indoors is only allowed for PE, sports and singing.

Students should continue their personal hygiene habits, e.g. hand washing, and keep common areas clean by wiping down surfaces where necessary. Students should be socially responsible. Those who are unwell should stay at home and seek medical treatment if necessary. Students are to still bring their Trace Together tokens daily.

F. PRIMARY 1 INTEGRATED TRAIL

To imbue in our students a joy of learning and to provide students with the opportunity to apply the concepts that they have learnt in class to real-life scenarios, all P1 students will be going on an integrated learning trail to KidsSTOP at the Singapore Science Centre.

The P1 integrated trail provides students with the opportunity to visit a dedicated Children's Science Centre where they can inquire, investigate and innovate in an indoor gallery that focuses on Science for the children. Through themed zones like Flight & Space, Planet Warriors and Know your Body and much more, students will learn the concepts of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics through interactive play.

G. PRIMARY 2 INTEGRATED TRAIL

To imbue in our students a joy of learning and to provide students with the opportunity to apply the concepts that they have learnt in class to real-life scenarios, all P2 students will be going on an integrated learning trail to Kok Fah Technological Farm.

The P2 integrated trail provides students with the opportunity to visit a local farm. Students will have a guided tour in the Greenhouse and learn about traditional and modern farming methods. The students will have a hands on experience of harvesting their own hydroponics vegetables and potting of microgreens. The students will also gain a better understanding of where their vegetables come from.

As part of the visit, students will be provided with an Aloe Vera Jelly for their snack break. Please note that the Aloe Vera Jelly is made with Aloe Vera grown from the farm. It is all natural and no preservatives have been added. Please indicate in the notes section if you would like your child to **opt out** from having the jelly.

Please note that Safe Management Measures will be put in place for the visit. There will only be one class visiting the farm on each day. The Greenhouse, briefing area and the activity area will be cordoned off and there will be no intermingling with the public. The students will be in their masks at all times. They will also be split up into smaller groups for the various activities at the farm.
