e-Oral

Reading Aloud

- Characters/ words (P1 to P6)
- Important to practise reading the textbook passages

Conversation

- Watch a video with a theme
- Able to engage in a conversation with the examiner
- Able to give opinion and elaborate on it clearly

- Listen to radio programmes

READING

- Make full use of the textbook
- Get your child to read aloud the P6 texts with you
- Read MT story books
- Subscribe to Student Magazine such as Thumbs Up

- Bring your child to the library to borrow books
- Write card/ journal/ short notes
